

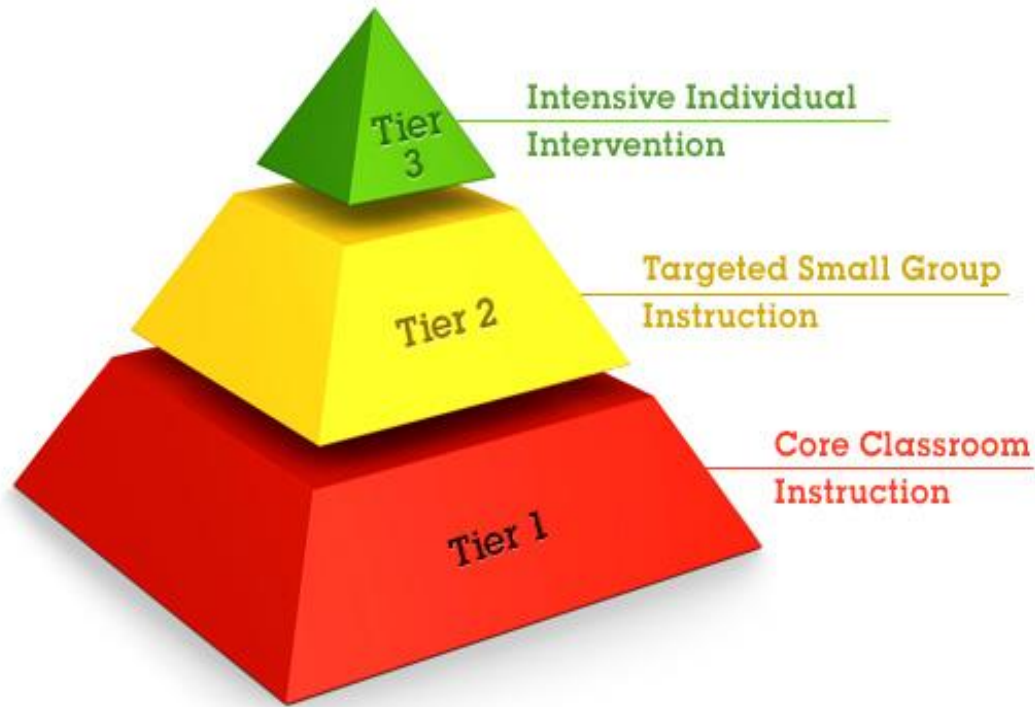

What is RTI?

- A method of academic intervention used to provide early, systematic assistance to students who are having difficulty learning
- General education framework
- Research-based instruction and interventions
- Monitoring of student progress
- Use of data to make decisions

Three-Tiered Support Model



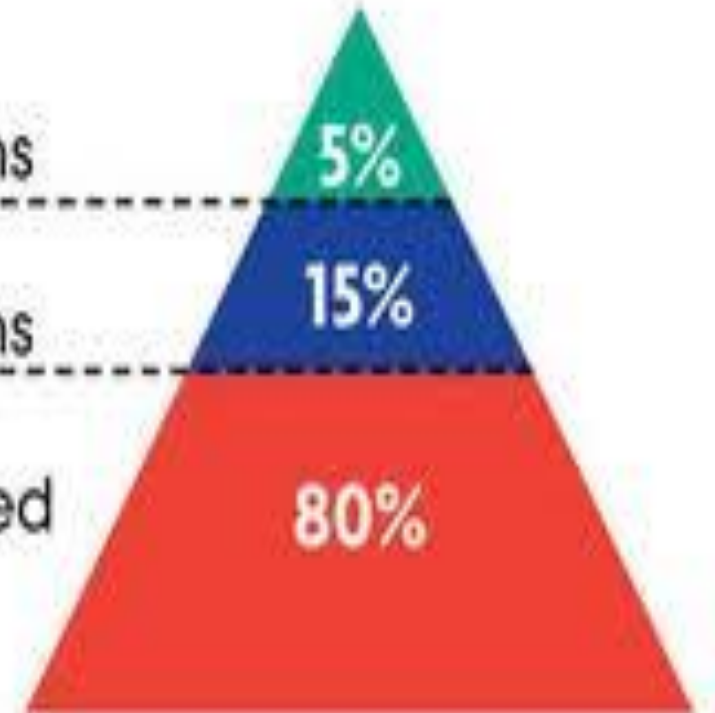
RTI (Response To Intervention)

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• General Common Core Curriculum with Differentiated Interventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Targeted small group instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Research-based and evidence-based intervention
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Regular classroom setting▪ If student is referred to IRSC, teacher implements recommendations from IRSC team	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Maximum of 18 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Maximum of 12 weeks
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Universal screening and progress monitoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Frequent progress monitoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ More frequent progress monitoring
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 80-90% of students	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 5-15% of students	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 1-5% of students
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Students who require additional support may be considered for Tier 2 interventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ After a maximum duration of 18 weeks, students will either return to Tier 1 or be recommended for Tier 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ After a maximum duration of 12 weeks, students will either return to Tier 1 or receive further evaluation

Universal Screening Assessment

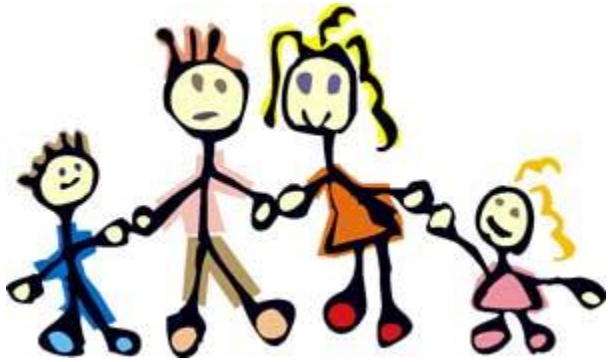
Examples:

- DIBELS Next (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills)
- DRA 2 (Developmental Reading Assessment)
- MAPS (Measure of Academic Progress)
- Study Island Pre and Post Test

Progress Monitoring

Examples:

- Words Their Way Spelling Inventory
- DRA 2 Progress Monitoring Assessment
- Running Records
- Grade Level Benchmark Assessments
